RESOLUTION 25-003

APPROVING VACATION OF CLARION AVENUE IN SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township, Lucas County, Ohio met in Regular Session on March 4, 2025 at 7617 Angola Road, Holland, Ohio, with the following members present:

Andrew Glenn and Tom Anderson Jr.

Andrew Glenn moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, Springfield Township (the "Township") is in receipt of a request to approve the vacation of a portion of Clarion Avenue, a public road within the Township; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5553.04(B) requires that the Lucas County Board of Commissioners first obtain the approval of the applicable board of township trustees before adopting a resolution to vacate a public road that is a township road; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that the vacation of the subject township road is in the interest of public convenience and welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Springfield Township Board of Trustees, Lucas County, Ohio, that:

Section 1: In accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5553.04(B), the Board of Trustees of Springfield Township hereby request and approve the vacation of that portion of Clarion Avenue, a public road within Springfield Township, depicted and described legal description both attached hereto, subject to any easements as required under Ohio Revised Code Section 5553.043.

Section 2: The Township Fiscal Officer is directed to (i) post or cause a copy of this Resolution to be posted in five (5) conspicuous public places within the Township for thirty (30) days, and (ii) cause this Resolution to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the Township for three (3) consecutive weeks.

Section 3: This Resolution shall become effective upon the posting of this Resolution and the publication of this Resolution as provided in Section 2 hereof. The Township Administrator is authorized to annex to this Resolution a separate writing which sets forth the completion dates of the posting and publishing requirements and the effective date of this Resolution.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.



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Depiction and Legal Description of Partially Vacated Road

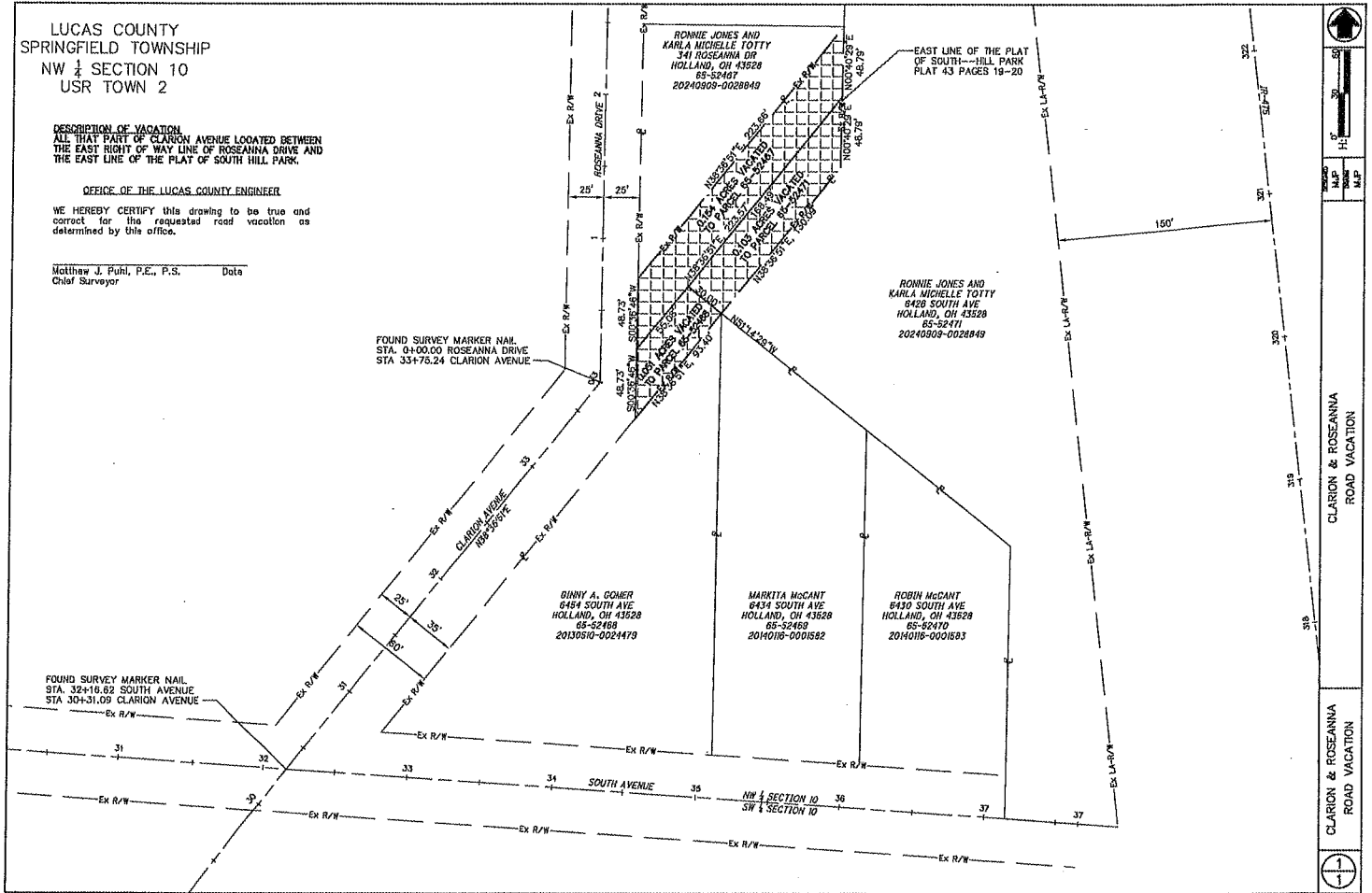
