Josh Hollinger, Zoning Inspector, 7617 Angola Road was sworn in by Tom Anderson, Jr. and presented a request to change the zoning of the property at 9450 Airport Highway from C-2 General Commercial to M-1 Limited Industrial. The request was recommended for approval by the Springfield Township Planning Commission on January 28, 2026, and by the Springfield Township Zoning Commission on February 10, 2026.

The applicant wants the zoning change to operate a light industrial business on the property. Staff determined the change is appropriate for the area, compatible with surrounding land uses, and consistent with the Springfield Township land use map, which already recommends industrial use for that location. Staff recommendation is to approve.

Josh Hollinger, Zoning Inspector, 7617 Angola Road was sworn in by Tom Anderson, Jr. and presented the request for a text amendment to the Springfield Township zoning fee schedule. It was reviewed by the Lucas County Planning Commission on January 28, 2026, and the Springfield Township Zoning Commission on February 10, 2026, both of which recommended approval.

The amendment adds a definition for “refacing” a sign to clarify the process when applying for a zoning permit. Previously, businesses replacing only the sign face on an existing frame had to pay the same fee as constructing a completely new sign. The change lowers the fee for sign refacing and clarifies that it applies only when the frame remains unchanged and only the sign face is replaced. Staff recommendation is to approve.

Josh Hollinger, Zoning Inspector, 7617 Angola Road was sworn in by Tom Anderson, Jr. and presented the request for a zoning change to R-1 Single-Family Residential for a proposed subdivision consisting of single-family homes. The proposal was reviewed by the Lucas County Planning Commission on January 28, 2026, and the Springfield Township Zoning Commission on February 10, 2026, both of which recommended approval.

The area is considered appropriate for single-family residential use, is compatible with surrounding land uses, and is consistent with the nearby neighborhood across the street that is already zoned R-1. Staff do not anticipate negative impacts on the surrounding area and therefore recommend approval of the zoning change.

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- Comments in Favor – Don Feller of Feller Finch & Associates, located at 1683 Woodlands Drive, Maumee, Ohio, spoke on behalf of the applicant. He noted that the project has already been recommended for approval by both the Planning Commission and the Zoning Commission. The property is located on the north side of Hill Avenue, just west of and adjacent to I-475/US-23. He stated that the proposal complies with the Springfield Township master plan, which identifies the parcel as R-1 residential, and he offered to answer any questions from the board.
- Comments in Opposition – Mr. and Mrs. Beck of 242 Connelville both addressed concerns of increased traffic, negative environmental impact, and types of housing potentially being built. Rebecca Castillo of 6538 Hill Avenue addressed concerns about the number of homes being built, number of entrances required and potential drainage issues.

The board emphasized that the decision at this meeting is only about zoning. If zoning is approved, the developer may continue researching and designing the project. There would be additional public meetings later where the detailed plans would be reviewed. The project is still early in the process for their concerns. The current decision only determines whether the developer can move forward with detailed studies and planning.

Fire/EMS Monthly Report, Jonathon Ziehr, Fire Chief

The Springfield Township Fire Chief presented the department's monthly report and explained a proposed Stryker EMS equipment contract, connecting it to a 2024 levy approved by voters that included funding for upgraded EMS equipment such as cardiac monitors, ambulance cots, lift systems, CPR devices, stair chairs, and AEDs. Beginning in October, the department conducted a trial comparing Stryker and Zoll, the two leading manufacturers of cardiac and CPR equipment, and after evaluating both, 86% of the department preferred continuing with Stryker, which the township has used for over 30 years with reliable service support. Benjamin Brouwer, Stryker representative, explained their proposed eight-year EMS Plus program, which would provide about thirty pieces of new equipment along with maintenance and repair coverage for both new and existing equipment, including parts, labor, batteries, and annual preventive maintenance. The plan would cost about \$195,005 per year, which already includes the department's current \$50,000 annual maintenance plan, making budgeting more predictable. The structure functions similarly to a lease but is a purchase, with the township owning all equipment after eight years

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for a \$1 buyout and having the option to continue maintenance service afterward. The Chief also noted that the department negotiated the price down from over \$214,000 per year after competitor pricing dropped, securing the lower rate.

Fire and Rescue Operations Highlights

- The recruitment team interviewed several candidates for part-time contingent positions, recommending three candidates to be taken to the Board for recommendation to hire.
- Assistant Chief Sauder chaired the Fire HUB Committee Meeting held downtown at the 911 building. This meeting focuses on operations and completes the Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) and Mayday policies to be approved by the Lucas County Fire Chiefs and used across the county for consistency amongst all agencies.
- A meeting was conducted with Jake Osgood and Captain Kokocinski, regarding fleet maintenance, specifically to discuss the mechanical issues with reserve Engine 54. This engine is the oldest in our fleet (2011) and will be replaced in June of this year. Instead of rebuilding or replacing the engine inside the pumper, Engine 54 will be used as a last-out reserve unit until the new engine arrives, after which it will be sold on GovDeals. The chief noted he was only informing the trustees and not requesting any action.




